TBMA aims to deliver a high quality level of services whereby reliability plays an important factor. Respect for the privacy of our customers and a careful handling of their personal information is an important part in obtaining a high service level. The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to tell you how TBMA practices the collection, use, and disclosure of information that you may provide via this site. Please be sure to read this entire Privacy Policy before using or submitting information to this site. This site is governed by applicable Dutch laws. Use of this site constitutes your consent to application of such laws and regulations and to our Privacy Policy.

Your Consent

By using this site, you agree with the terms of this Privacy Policy. Whenever you submit information via this site, you consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of that information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Active Information Collection

Like many web sites, this site actively collects information from its visitors both by asking you specific questions and by permitting you to communicate directly with us via e-mail. Some of the information that you submit may be personally identifiable information (that is, information that can be uniquely identified with you such as your full name, address, e-mail address, phone number, and so on). Passive Information Collection

Persistent cookies store information on your computer for a number of purposes, such as retrieving certain information you have previously provided (e.g., passwords), helping to determine what areas of the Web site visitors find most valuable, and customizing the Web site based on your preferences. This site uses cookies mainly to store your default preferences.
